

## PUBLIC PARTICIPATION NOTICE

### ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF BADEN POWELL / MACASSAR ROAD TRAFFIC CIRCLE

The City of Cape Town intends to upgrade the four-way stop at Baden Powell Drive and the Macassar Road intersection to a traffic circle. These roads provide direct access to key regional transport routes. With the proposed upgrade, improved traffic flow for current and projected road traffic for the wider area will be achieved. The upgrade will include additional lanes entering and exiting the traffic circle.

#### Location

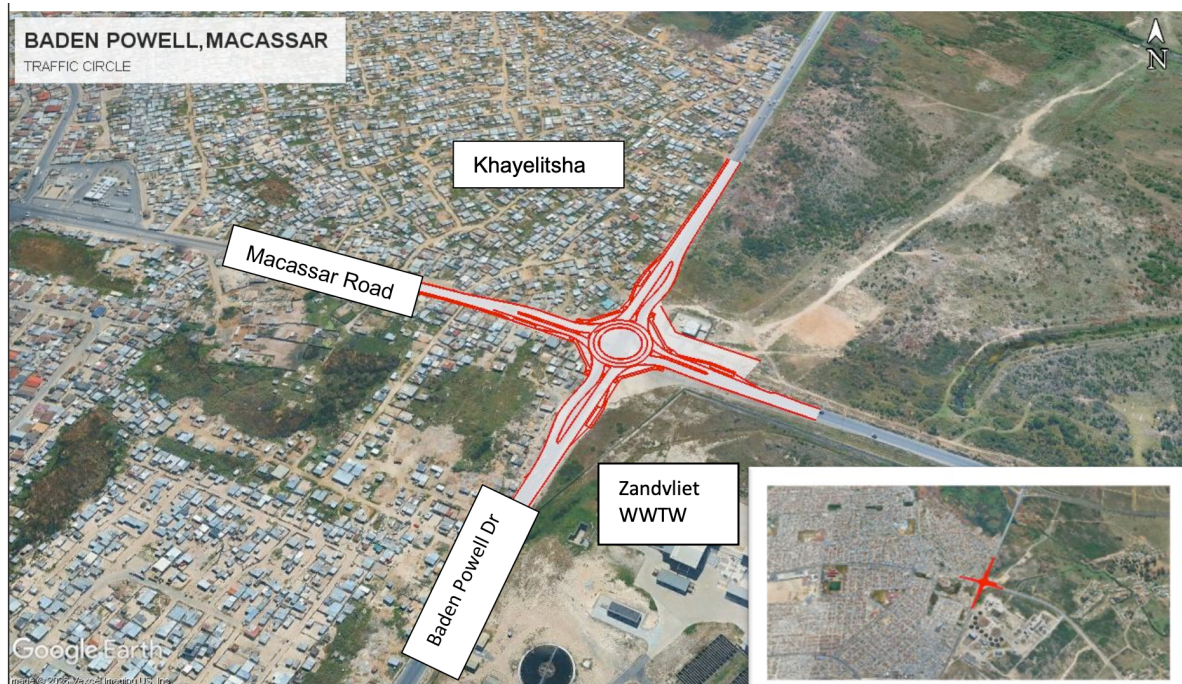
The site is located in Macassar along Baden Powell Drive (R310) and Macassar Road intersection within the City of Cape Town, Western Cape (34.048461°S, 18.718494°E).

#### Application for environmental authorisation to undertake the following activities

The project requires an environmental assessment in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, (107 of 1998), and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, as amended. The proposed development includes activities in Listings Notice 1 (GNR 983 of 2014, as amended) Activity 19, and Listings Notice 3 (GNR 985 of 2014, as amended), Activity 15.
